Financial

During the period that covered from June 1, 2018 to September 30, 2018, we were working under a No Cost Extension for 2017-2018-001 Subaward Agreement. By the beginning of August our budget was already spent creating a net overbudget of \$18,558.26 by the end of the month.

We continued with our basic operations, using our indirect cost funds and limiting our expenses until November 10 when we received the transfer of funds corresponding to the project 2nd quarter of the subaward (September, October and November).

The following table (TABLE 1) represent the budget submitted and approved for all the quarters totaling \$593,680. Because we projected that we would be working under a no-cost extension (as we established previously) for the second year, no funds were requested for the first quarter (June to September). Then, the projection for the second quarter is \$296,293.

Milestones Status:

- Secure vessels, materials and personnel required for the deployment and retrieval of gliders in the region, their maintenance and shipping when required.
 - We have some technical staff who already completed training for piloting and the proper handling of gliders and batteries. Also, we have some experienced sailors and their boats ready to deploy and retreive the gliders on time.
- Providing administrative services required for organizational affairs and administration in compliance with applicable requirements and regulations.
 - We are in continuous review of the federal and state regulations for compliance
- Contract staff for data management (DMAC), HP Computing services and other leadership positions.
 - We have renewed the contracts of both
- Contract cloud computing services resources for data archival, operational modelling and web page operation.
 - We are in the process of contract Amazon Web Services for such a service. The contract will be annual.
- Contracting web page maintenance and upgrades.
 - We already contracted Candela Creative Group
- Manage the OTT initiative for reef data stewardship and publication as per MBON standards.
 - It is expected that the process will end before next summer.
- Contract customer discovery process towards identification of sea-state data products to be included in the CARICOOS Boat App and contract its development, delivery and publication.
 - We are in the process It is expected that by the end of December the necessary data will be available for the development of the Boat App.
